

"Tetelestai: It Is Finished"

As Jesus hung on the cross in His final moments, one powerful word was spoken: "Tetelestai." Often translated as "It is finished," this single word carries profound meaning that reaches to the very heart of the Christian faith.

The word tetelestai comes from Greek, the language in which the New Testament was written.

It was commonly used in everyday life during biblical times, and its meaning went far beyond simply "ending" something. It meant to bring something to completion, to accomplish a purpose, or even to pay a debt in full. In fact, historical records show that this word would be written across receipts to indicate that a bill had been completely paid.

When Jesus cried out "tetelestai" from the cross, He was not expressing defeat, but victory. His mission, given by God, had been fully accomplished. Every prophecy pointing to the Messiah, every act of obedience, and ultimately His sacrificial death had reached its intended fulfillment.

This moment reminds us that Christ's work on the cross was sufficient. Nothing more needs to be added. The debt of sin, which humanity could never repay on its own, was fully settled through His sacrifice. "Paid in full" is not just a phrase it is the reality of what Jesus declared.

For believers today, tetelestai is a word of assurance and hope. It tells us that forgiveness is not something we must earn, but something already completed through Christ. It invites us to rest in the finished work of Jesus, trusting that what He accomplished on the cross is enough.

As we reflect on this powerful word, may we remember that the story does not end with the cross, but it is through the cross that victory was secured. "Tetelestai" is not the end of hope; it is the beginning of new life.

It is finished. And because of that, we are free.
