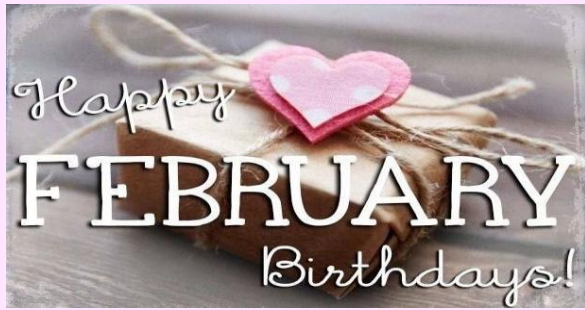

### **Ronald McDonald House**

The Ronald McDonald House is located on Monument Avenue in Richmond, VA. It provides temporary housing and support services to families with a child being seen in any local medical facility and must travel far from home for their child's care. Ronald McDonald Family Room at Bon Secours St. Mary's Hospital is close to the pediatric ICU. This is a place to get a bite to eat or grab some rest. Hospitality Carts, operated by volunteers, are stocked with snacks, toiletries, activities and toys to provide comfort in children's hospital rooms. Additional services include "Lunches with Love" and the RMHC Sibling Center.

**First Responders** – Hanover Fire Fighters gave a safety presentation at the January JOY Luncheon. Planning to partner with homeschoolers to take snacks to the Laurel Meadows station. Date TBD

**MCEF** – collecting: mayo, canned meat, creamed corn, assorted jellies

**Healing Quilts** – meeting regularly. Quilt was presented to Pete Bradley as he recovers.

**Naomi Circle** – met 1/19. Card ministry to young people and loved ones. Missionary names distributed for prayer. Feminine products collected for MCEF. "Teacher Treats" were packed and delivered to RPES and WHES as well as snacks for needy students at WHES.

**CARITAS** - (30 meals for the ladies' facility) Thanks to Gloria Harrison for coordinating this ministry. Delivery planned for mid-Feb. 2026. Homeschoolers decorate bags for this project. (kids on Mission!)

**Harbour Square** - Desiree Lytton heads this ministry. Deliveries last Sunday of each month to 25 families. Missions Team was among the 2025 recipients of a Hallelujah Grant from the Watson Offering Funds to support this ministry.

**Kroger** – 52 households participating. Encourage others to sign up. Instructions for signing up located in Common Grounds. Check for last quarter was \$172.83.

**Church Hill (River City Faith Network)** – Beverly Sweeney attends Bible Study, and reports needs to this team. Items from the Warming Tree will be shared with this ministry.

**Moments of Hope** – continuing to collect single pup tents, sleeping bags, blankets, coats, underwear, socks, flashlights, and batteries for the homeless. The Director picks up items on a regular basis.

**Bloom (PRC)** - We provide baby bottle banks once a quarter to be filled with cash/checks to donate to this ministry. Collection on January 18th "Sanctity of Life" Sunday was \$167. Thank you for supporting this life-saving ministry.

### **Misc. –**

1. We are collecting tabs from cans to donate to **Ronald McDonald House**. They use them to pay the electric bill.
2. **Warming Tree** will receive hats, gloves, mittens, scarves, and socks of all sizes. These are shared with MCEF, Moments of Hope, and The River City Faith Network. Tree stays up through February 2026.
